## Week 2: Exodus 20:7

- 1. Share some thoughts on what it means to take the Lord's name in vain. Are there things that surprise you?
- 2. What does it mean to you to hear the name of "Yahweh"? Does that invoke any special feelings in you?
- 3. What do you think it looks like to profane and desecrate God's name of "Yahweh"? Certain texts translate this commandment as "to take lightly" or "as no significance"; how would that make you feel about God's name?
- 4. In all honesty with your group, how do you personally use God's name? Do you treat it without reverence, or with profanity? Think about where you might use God's name.
- 5. When we use God's name in a vow (think in a courtroom setting, or in your marriage vows), what is the implication when it is used there?
- 6. If God is known by the way we represent him, what would the world see?
- 7. Think about your sphere of influence. Are you shining the bright light of Jesus Christ to them by your words, thoughts and actions? Discuss with your group.
- 8. Share with your group if there was a specific thought or idea from the sermon this week that spoke to you or was a new concept.
