## Study Questions

Week 9: Exodus 20:16

1. What is the scope of “do not bear false witness”? What does that mean to you?
2. When you think about the term “consequences”, do you immediately think about good ones or bad ones? Why? Discuss with your group.
3. Think of a time in your own life when you experienced a bad consequence of an action you had made. Share that experience with your group. What did you learn from that experience?
4. In consideration of the Olympics this past week, what do you think some of the consequences we have observed this week. Discuss with your group.
5. When we speak a false witness, or a lie, about someone or something, are we honoring God?
6. Truth telling can be very difficult. In hindsight, the pain of a bad consequence can be worse than telling the truth in the first place. What does that mean to you?
7. Share with your group if there was a specific thought or idea from the sermon this week that spoke to you or was a new concept.
