A Thank You from the Florida Conference A few weeks ago, New Covenant received a Thank You note from the Florida Conference for paying 100% of our 2020 apportionments.

Apportionments are our share of the funding of the budgets of The United Methodist Church around the world, the Florida Conference, and the church Districts. This includes not only general operations but also missions & missionaries, financial assistance for college students, food programs, starting new churches, etc.



For 2020, our apportionment was \$179,481 or about 4.6% of our annual budget. Our 2021 apportionment is \$146,166 or 4.0% of our budget. Thank you for helping us pay one-twelfth of the apportionment monthly near the first of each month.


