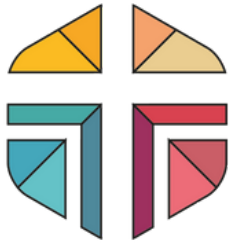

Time in a Bottle

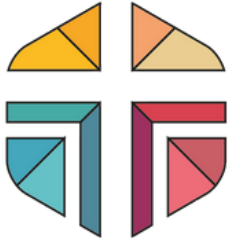
How many times have each of us said “no” to working on a church project because we think it will take too much of our time? Maybe we would even say “steal our time.”

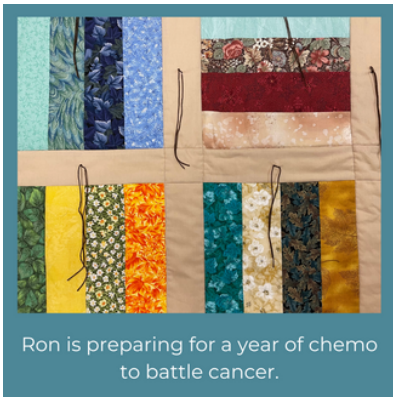

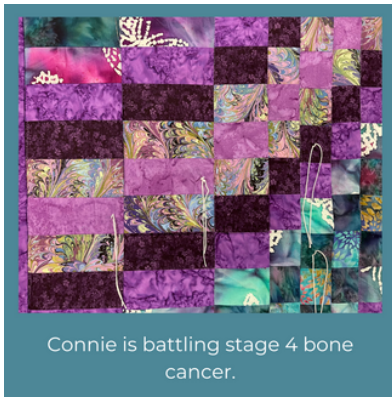
