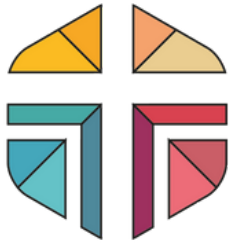

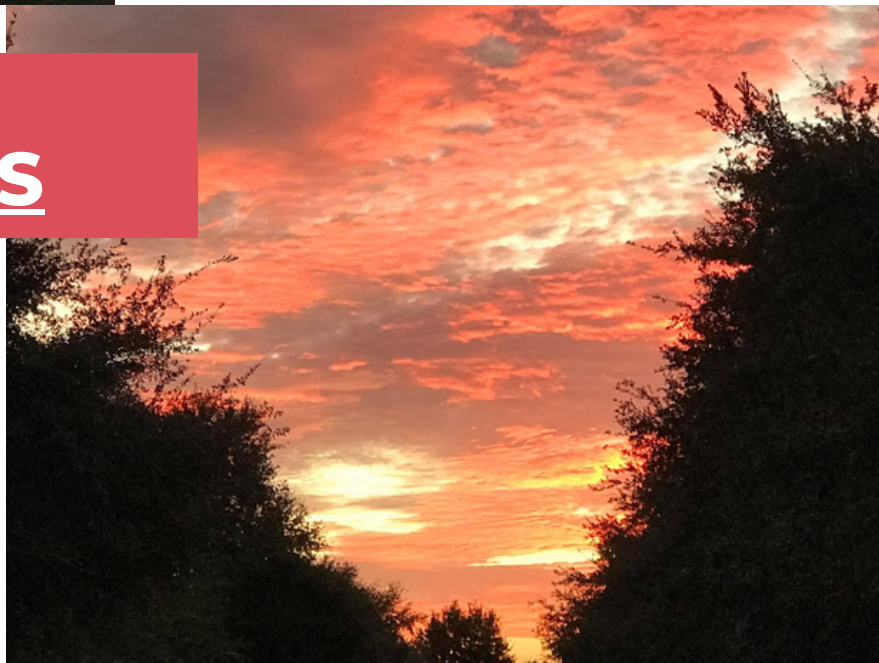


COFFEE BAR

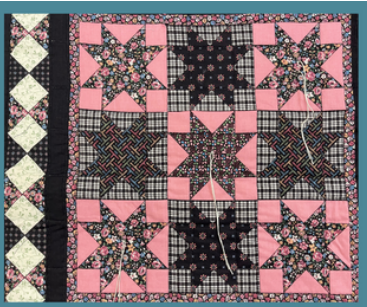
