

## **STEWARDSHIP**

**Church Attendance Leads to Generosity** Generosity is a byproduct of discipleship. The more engaged—small groups, Sunday school, and regular church attendance—the more generous people are with their churches.

Church members attending worship:

- 1 service per month on average give 1% of their income
- 2 services per month on average give 2% of their income
- 2+ services per month and in a small group, participate in service projects, etc., on average give 4+% of their income



Total giving nationwide in the US remains at 2%. However, the portion going to churches from 1980 through 2019 dropped from 56% to 29%.

Therefore, it's very important to continue to support your church financially but even more important for you, as we move out of this pandemic, to join a small group and/or become active in a ministry that is of interest to you.

#### ADMINISTRATION OFFICE



#### LOL CONNECT SMALL GROUP


