STEWARDSHIP

Budget Time

This week the finance committee approved a preliminary budget for 2021. It's been quite a task to plan worship services, Bible Study classes, Care department activities, and overall administration of your church in the midst of this pandemic. What will 2021 be like, even when a vaccine starts becoming available?

The proposed 2021 budget has total income projected to be \$3,277,000, which is down \$574,824, or 15%, from our 2020 budget. Our spending will, therefore, be required to be

decreased roughly the same amount. It has been difficult for our directors and staff to determine what to change, or even possibly eliminate what we were doing before March of this year. But they have done it. However, in order to avoid additional budget cuts, it is very necessary for all of us to continue to support our church.
