MENTEE SCHOLARSHIP

The Love Offering collected during our Carols & Candlelight services will be used towards a scholarship program established for our Wildwood Middle High School Mentees. Established in 2014, mentors from New Covenant UMC and the community are matched with incoming 8th graders at WMHS. These mentors visit their mentees weekly during the school year and provide ongoing support for their students. The mentors "move up" with their mentees each year for a total of five years.



The goal of our program has been to create a partnership between local churches and students at Wildwood Middle High School by providing a Mentor Program for identified students, which provides ongoing encouragement, support, and love.

This school year, we will have our third group of mentees graduating. These students have been within the mentor program for the past four or five years. Your generosity is funding scholarships for each graduating class. We are proud of our upcoming graduates and their commitment to their education. Some of our previous mentees are currently enrolled at Lake Sumter State College, Withlacoochee Technical Center, and Lake Technical; additionally, we've had a student who received her certification in Phlebotomy!
