

Financial Fun Facts



Fun Fact #1: To protect us from COVID-19 the church in 2020 spent \$21,437 to have the entire church treated twice by an outside company with a special COVID-19 killing treatment and for in-house COVID-19 killing sprays, wipes, and testing equipment.




Fun Fact #2: For the year 2020, the church paid \$2,867 to purchase The Upper Room and collected \$1,175 from the sale of it.


