### Church Conference

- Sunday, May 31 at 4 p.m. — Christian Life Center, Summerhill Campus

A Church Conference will be held to vote on the following item on the ballot:

- As a member of New Covenant United Methodist Church, I vote to launch the Lake Deaton campus as a separate United Methodist Church effective July 1, 2020. (Circle one) YES NO

Following the Church Conference, if the launch is approved, those who intend to become members of the Lake Deaton Church will remain for a Constituting Church Conference and the following will take place:

- » Be welcomed into membership of the new church
- » Approve the new name of the church
- » Approve the 2020 slate of the lay leadership roster as presented

At the conclusion of the Constituting Church Conference, a Charge Conference will be called by the District Superintendent and the newly elected leadership team will vote on the following:

- » Incorporate under the new name of the church
- » Request an interest-only loan for up to two years or for a time period as determined by the Foundation

As a reminder, only Full Members who are present are permitted to vote. Associate and Affiliate Members may not vote, but may certainly attend. If the Church Conference vote is favorable, the intent will be to launch July 1. If not, there will be a reevaluation by the leadership team.
