## **Group Discussion Questions**

### **Week 4: Genesis 41:25-40**

- 1.** From the prison, Joseph is summoned to hear Pharaoh's dreams. If you were Joseph, what kind of emotions would you be feeling?
- 2.** Pharaoh clearly is troubled by the dreams he is having. Joseph has had great success in interpreting the dreams of those he has encountered. What would be at stake for Joseph if he says something that Pharaoh does not like?
- 3.** Pharaoh hears the interpretations. Joseph continues to tell him what Pharaoh needs to do in response. Do you think that was a risk?
- 4.** When Joseph made the announcement on what Pharaoh should do to solve the problem, Pharaoh does the unthinkable – he appoints Joseph to be his 2<sup>nd</sup> in command. This is a big job but Pharaoh believes he is up to the task. Have you ever faced a big job or responsibility, and what were your emotions surrounding it?
- 5.** Joseph will become an authority on managing the food to prepare for the famine. What kind of skills would he need for this important role?
- 6.** What was something that was particularly meaningful to you from this week's sermon or from your discussion time.
